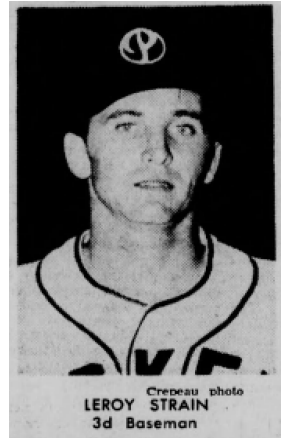

Veteran hurler Lee Walker did just about everything except sell tickets and sweep out the grandstand last Friday night in Recreation Park, pitching and batting the Healdsburg Prune Packers to a 6 to 4 revenge victory over the Fort Bragg Loggers.

Not until after Walker opened the fifth inning with a strikeout did the local fans see much action from the other Packers. Although the Loggers scored one run on two hits in the first four innings, Walker accounted for the first 13 Prune Packer put-outs in 4½ innings with strikeouts.

He also led the locals at bat, driving in the opening Healdsburg run in the second inning with a line drive triple to right field, which scored Don Sbragia from third base.

Walker climaxed his one-man show by breaking up a 4 to 4 tie in the eighth with a center field double, which brought home Bill Maddox and Leroy Strain for the winning margin.
